**CARRIAGEWAY RECONSTRUCTION WORKS IN SHANKLIN ROAD, GODSHILL**

We are writing to let you know about the carriageway improvement works due to take place in your local area shortly, and to provide you with some information and guidance in relation to what will happen during the works, to enable you to plan accordingly. During this work no on-street parking and no vehicle through access will be permitted within the areas of closure.

We recognise that these improvement works may cause some inconvenience for residents and businesses, but we hope any disruption will be offset by the long-term improvements we are making. We would like to thank you in advance for your assistance in enabling us to complete these works.

Please note, there are a variety of factors including inclement weather and emergency works that may affect the timing of works. Please watch the on-site boards for confirmation/changes of the start date / duration (example shown below).



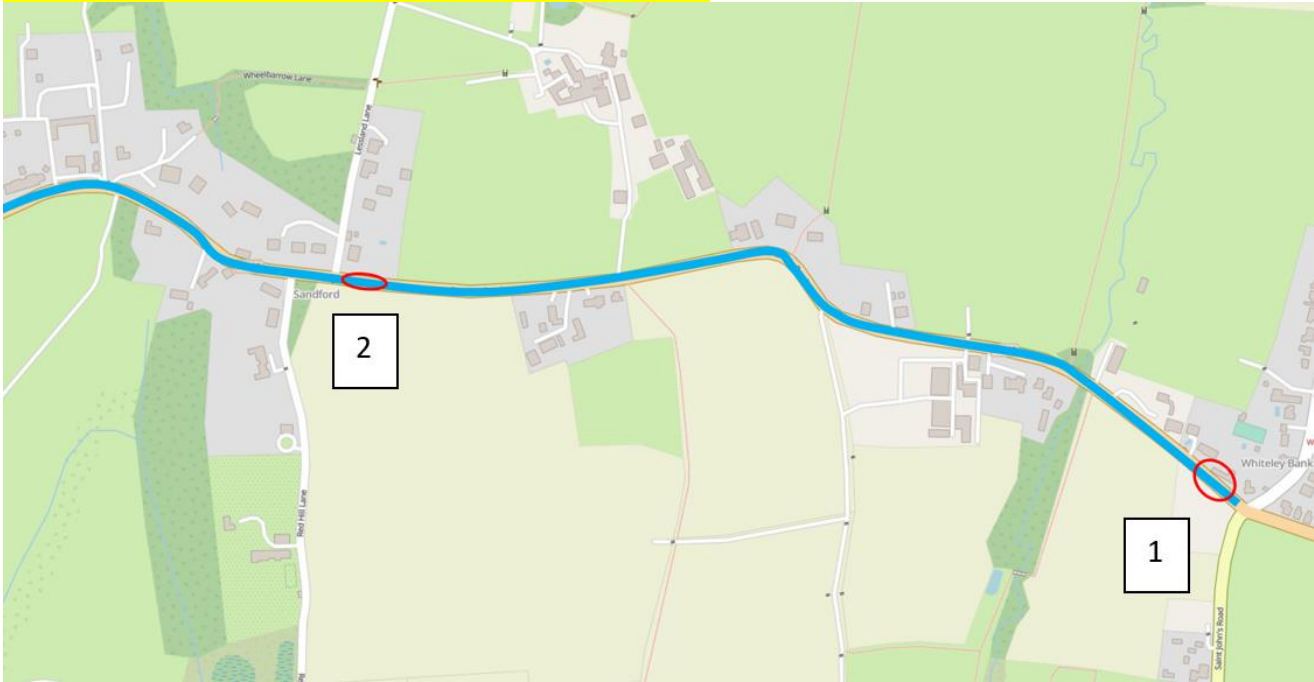
**Timing of the works:**

- Reconstruction works due to start W/C 7<sup>th</sup> October 2024 for approximately 6 working days.

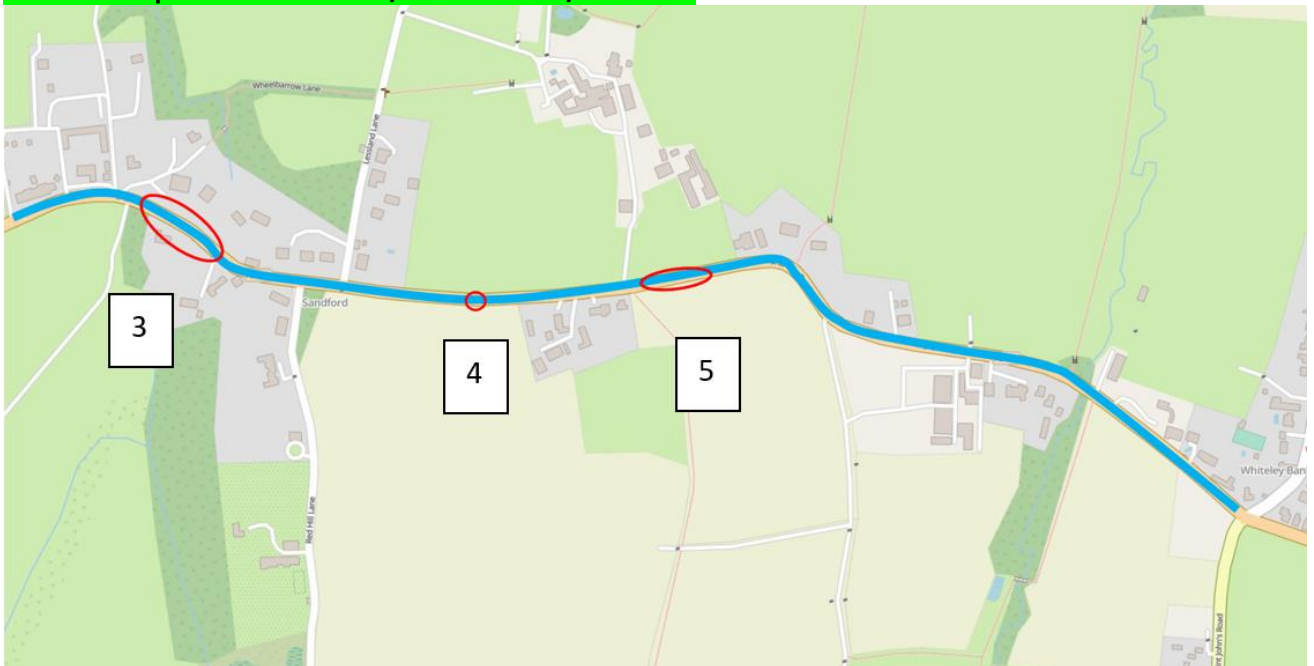
**RECONSTRUCTION WORKS – INFORMATION**

<b>Location of works</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shanklin Road, Godshill between Canteen Road and Sandford Cottages. (area of works circled in red on the attached plans).</li> </ul>
<b>Road Closure / At All times</b> <b>Day 1 – 3</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Location 1 will take approx. 2 days. The crew will then move onto Location 2 for approx. 1 day.</li> </ul>
<b>Road Closure / 09:30 – 16:00</b> <b>Day 4 - 6</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The crew will commence works on Location 3, then work in order of Location 4 then Location 5 over these three days.</li> </ul>
<b>Time of works</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 07:00 – 17:00 (weekdays only)</li> </ul>
<b>Safety measures during works:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vehicle access will be prohibited at all times within the area of works.</li> <li>• Only when it is safe to do so, resident access will be maintained within the road closure extent outside of the area of works.</li> <li>• Should you require your vehicle during the dates of work we would recommend parking in an alternative location.</li> <li>• “No Parking” cones will be placed out the night prior to works commencing.</li> <li>• No pedestrian or cyclist through route.</li> <li>• Emergency vehicle access will be maintained.</li> <li>• No access onto Shanklin Road from Lessland Lane during the works on Location 2.</li> </ul>

**Access**

**Vehicle Removal**

We would ask that you do not park within the confines of the works or any areas that have had “no parking” cones put out before the start of the works and for the duration of the works. Failure to do so will result in your vehicle being moved.

**Waste Collection Including Commercial Waste**

If these works coincide with your usual domestic waste collection day, please ensure your waste is on the kerbside before 7am to enable its collection or contact your service provider to make alternative arrangements with them.

**In an Emergency**

We work closely with the emergency services and will assist the emergency services to safely pass through the site, should they need to access the works area in the event of an emergency.
